**Procedure**  
**for organizing the admission of foreigners and stateless persons to the**  
**International European University**  
**in 2025**

**I. General Provisions**

1. Admission of foreigners and stateless persons to study at the International European University shall be carried out in accordance with the Laws of Ukraine “On Higher Education”, “On the Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons”, “On Foreign Ukrainians”, “On Refugees and Persons in Need of Additional or Temporary Protection”, “On Establishing Additional Legal and Social Guarantees for Citizens of the Republic of Poland Staying on the Territory of Ukraine”; Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated September 12, 2018 No. 729 “Issues of Obtaining Higher Education by Certain Categories of Persons”; the Procedure for Organizing Admission to Vocational (Vocational-Technical), Professional Pre-Higher, Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine and Education (Internship) of Foreigners and Stateless Persons Using the Unified Interdepartmental Information System of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons Wishing to Study at Vocational (Vocational-Technical), Professional Pre-Higher, Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine, approved by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated June 28, 2024 No. 758; Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated November 01, 2013 No. 1541 “Certain Issues of Organizing Recruitment and Education (Internship) of Foreigners and Stateless Persons”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 25, 2013 under No. 2004/24536; Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated December 02, 2019 No. 1498 “On Approval of the Procedure for Establishing Quotas for Obtaining Higher Education by Foreigners and Stateless Persons within the State Order Volumes in Accordance with International Treaties of Ukraine”, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 10, 2020 under No. 153/34436.

Citizens of the Russian Federation, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Republic of Belarus, and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea who do not have a permanent residence permit in Ukraine shall be admitted for study upon individual permission of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

2. Foreigners and stateless persons, stateless persons who have applied for recognition as refugees, persons who have applied for protection in Ukraine and have provided a Certificate of Application for Protection in Ukraine (hereinafter – foreigners), may obtain higher education at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities, unless otherwise provided by international treaties of Ukraine approved by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, legislation, or agreements between higher education institutions on international academic mobility.

Admission of foreigners and stateless persons, including foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, citizens of the Republic of Poland, persons recognized as refugees, and persons in need of additional protection, to state-funded places shall be carried out in accordance with paragraph 6 of Section III of the Procedure for Admission to Higher Education in 2025, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 168 dated February 10, 2025, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 26, 2025 under No. 15/41360.

Admission of foreigners to study for obtaining higher education shall be carried out for accredited educational programmes. International European University may also admit foreigners for study under preparatory faculty (department) programmes, for studying the state language and/or the language of instruction, as well as for obtaining postgraduate education, advanced training, and internships.

3. Admission of foreigners to study at the University may be conducted in person and/or remotely. Recruitment of foreigners for study shall be carried out using the Unified Interdepartmental Information System of Ukraine for foreigners and stateless persons wishing to study at vocational (vocational-technical), professional pre-higher, and higher education institutions of Ukraine (hereinafter – the Unified System).

The validity period of the electronic invitation to study issued through the Unified System shall not exceed six months from the date of affixing the qualified electronic seal of the International European University or the qualified electronic signature of an authorized person of the University.

An invitation to study issued through the Automated System “Electronic Journal” of the state enterprise authorized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine shall remain valid until April 01, 2025 inclusive.

Foreigners who have received an electronic invitation to study, obtained a package of information and consulting support services (in the event of receiving an invitation to study through the Automated System “Electronic Journal” of the state enterprise

authorized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine), and have completed the procedure for legalization of educational documents in the country of their issuance may participate in remote admission: legalization at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country that issued the educational document; legalization at the consular department of the diplomatic mission of Ukraine abroad (consular legalization or apostille).

For the organization of remote recruitment of foreigners for study to obtain higher education and for study under preparatory faculty (department) programmes, for studying the state language and/or the language of instruction, as well as for obtaining postgraduate education, advanced training, and internships, employees of the International European University conduct identification of the person and entrance examinations remotely with mandatory video recording (including recording of the applicant's device screen). The video recording of the entrance examination shall be stored after the examination for foreigners for five years at the International European University, and the link to this recording shall be entered into the Unified Database.

In the case of remote admission, the foreigner shall send legalized or notarized copies of documents on previous education to the International European University by postal service. Upon the first crossing of the state border of Ukraine and after arrival at the University, the foreigner shall personally submit the original documents.

4. Enrollment of applicants from among foreigners for study at the International European University at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities may be carried out:

1) twice a year within the periods determined by the Admission Rules for obtaining the degrees of Bachelor, Master, Doctor of Philosophy/Doctor of Arts (assistantship-internship):

- 01.03.2025 – 31.05.2025;
- 01.09.2025 – 31.10.2025;

2. throughout the year for study at the preparatory department (faculty).

The International European University calculates the applicant's points/grades based on the document on the previously obtained level of education and establishes the minimum required number of points/grades in general education subjects for which the entrance examination for foreigners is conducted.

Enrollment of foreigners for study at the relevant level of higher education shall be carried out on the basis of a document on the previously obtained level of education according to the results of the entrance examination for foreigners in biology, chemistry, and the language of instruction, and on the basis of academic rights for continuation of

studies granted by the educational document obtained in the country of origin, taking into account academic performance scores granting the right to continue studies at the next level of higher education in accordance with the legislation of the country that issued the document on the obtained degree (level) of education.

5. All categories of foreigners entering for study shall be enrolled at the International European University on the basis of enrollment orders. Confirmation of the fact of study may be a certificate generated in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education.

6. The requirements of the International European University regarding compliance of applicants from among foreigners who arrived in Ukraine for the purpose of study with the Procedure and the Admission Rules, as well as the *сроки* for submission of applications and documents, conducting the entrance examination for foreigners, and enrollment shall be specified in the Admission Rules and published on the official website of the International European University.

7. Foreigners who are granted state scholarships under international treaties, nationwide programmes, and other international obligations of Ukraine shall be admitted for study within the established quotas for foreigners on the basis of referrals issued by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

8. Foreigners arriving in Ukraine to participate in academic mobility programmes or to obtain higher education under educational programmes agreed between Ukrainian and foreign higher education institutions shall be admitted for study taking into account the contractual obligations of the respective higher education institutions.

9. Foreigners and stateless persons, including foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees, and persons in need of additional protection, shall have the right to obtain higher education on an equal basis with citizens of Ukraine, including at the expense of the state or local budget, except for cases established by the Constitution of Ukraine, the laws of Ukraine, or international treaties approved by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.
